

FOUR APN GOALS Related to the APN goals identified in the 3rd strategic plan?


RELATED TO ONE OF THE FOUR APN SCIENCE THEMES?

- 2. Ecosystems, Biodiversity & Land-Use
- 3. Changes in Atmospheric, Terrestrial, Marine Domains
- 4. Resources Utilisation & Pathways for Sustainable Development

AT LEAST 3 COUNTRIES?





- CO-FUNDING/IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS?
- REASONABLE BUDGET?

Will the outcomes be RELEVANT FOR THE APN REGION?

1. Are decision-makers involved?

2. Will the outcomes be useful for endusers?

3. Does the project adopt interdisciplinary approaches?

- 4. Does the proposal represent value for money?
- 5. Is the project realistic in terms of timescale and work to be done?

How to rate your proposals (be critical)

- 9-10: Excellent
- Significantly contributes to APN goals
- 7-8: Very Good
 - Fundamentally sound but needs some modification
- 5-6: Good
 - Could be sound but requires important modifications
- 3-4: Fair
 - Not yet sound and does not meet most of the criteria
- 1-2: Poor
 - Has fundamental flaws and need not be reconsidered

How should you present your reviews?

- General Strength and Weaknesses of the Proposals
- General Suggestions for Improving the Proposals
- Selection of the Best Proposal and Why.
