## **CALL FOR PAPERS**

- Research papers are invited for the ICOMSA 2015, 17-19 March 2015.
- Authors are requested to indicate if they wish to participate as an 'Observer' or 'Presenter' of papers (oral/poster). The scientific committee will decide on the suitability of papers for oral or poster presentation. All abstracts must be in English - the official language of the Conference.
- Each oral presenter shall be entitled to no more than 15 minutes for a presentation, plus 5 minutes for questions. Oral presentations should use Power Point. Overhead slide projectors and video cassette players will not be available or allowed.
- All presenters are required to pay for their own registration, accommodation and travel expenses.
- An Abstract Book will be printed and distributed to the registered attendees.
- Please be advised that authors who do not register and settle the full payment for this Conference before 31 January 2015 will NOT have their abstract included in the Abstract Book.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARATION OF ABSTRACTS**

- TITLE OF PAPER: The title is printed in CAPITAL LETTERS, with the exception of scientific names which should be in lower case and italicized. Scientific names should not be preceded or followed by commas or parentheses or other markings.
- AUTHOR(S): Indicate the presenting author with an asterisk (\*). Type in lower case.
- ADDRESS AND EMAIL: Type only the presenting author's institution, address and email. Type in upper/lower case.
- MAXIMUM LENGTH: One Page
- PAGE SIZE: Standard A4 paper (210mm x 297mm = 8.27" x 11.69")(portrait)
- MARGINS: 2.5cm margin throughout (left/right/top/ bottom)
- SPACING: Single spaced
- PARAGRAPHS: Paragraphs should be separated by a blank line and should not be indented.
- FONTS: Character fonts should be Arial 11 point type. Abstract should be no more than 300 words.

### **POSTER GUIDELINES**

- Rectangular poster boards of the size 76cm x 51cm will be provided. The posters should not exceed this size.
- Contents should be typed in sufficiently large font size which can be read from a 2 meter distance.
- The secretariat will provide mounting facilities.
