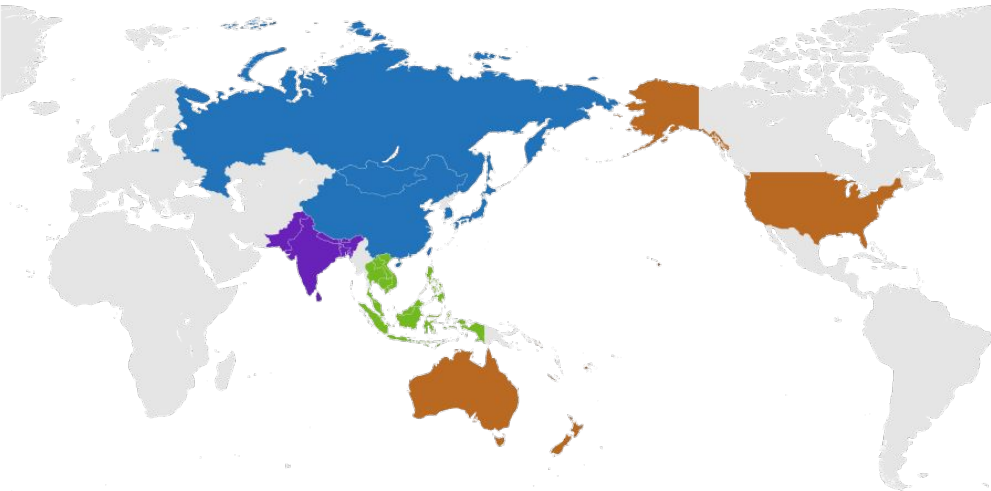

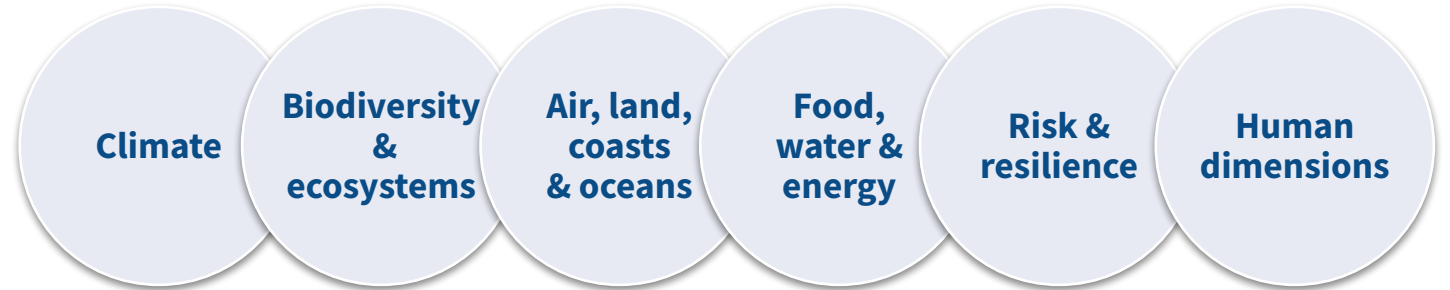

- Strengthen linkages between scientists, policymakers and practitioners etc. and provide sound scientific information for policymaking processes.

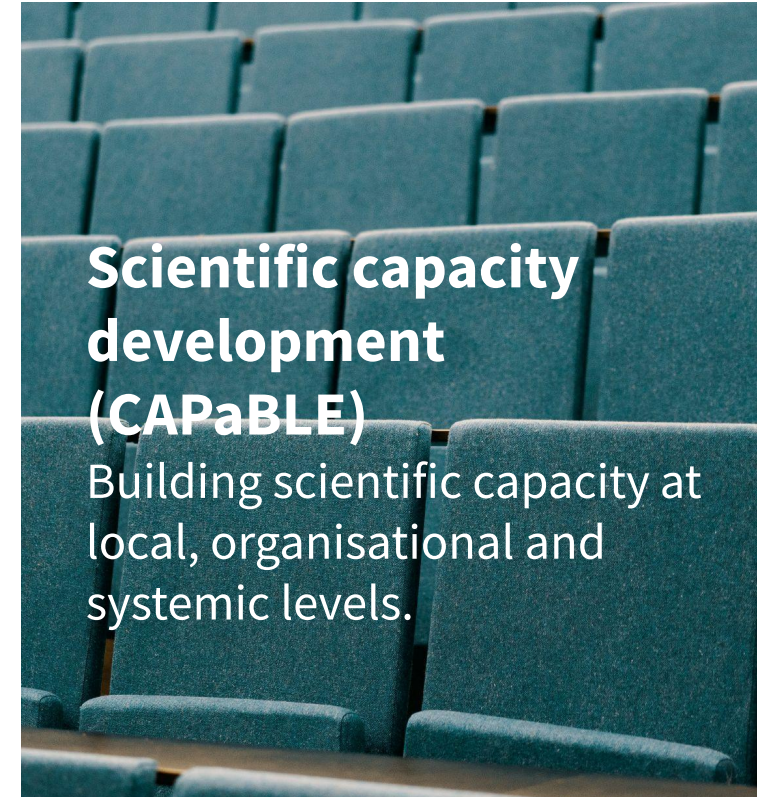

# APN Strategic Goals and Programmes



## Research

Supporting regional and international cooperation in research on global change and sustainability issues particularly relevant to the Asia-Pacific Region

### Collaborative Regional Research Programme (CRRP)

Engaging a minimum of 3 countries in the region, APN fosters the understanding of global environmental change by conducting Asia-Pacific regional-based research on the Earth's system and advancing science that informs decision-making in adaptation, mitigation, and sustainable development.

Typical project proposal duration within 1-2 years (*maximum 3 years*).  
Average funding per project year is USD 45,000.

## Capacity Development

Enhancing capacities to participate in research on global change and sustainability and to support science-based decision-making.

### Scientific Capacity Development Programme (CAPaBLE)

Enhancing the capacities of scientists, policymakers and other relevant stakeholders in Asia and the Pacific to identify and assess global change issues at local, national and regional levels and further identify appropriate solutions to resolve the issues and achieve sustainability.

Typical project proposal duration within 1 year (*maximum 2 years*).  
Average funding per project year is USD 40,000.

# ■ Programmes available under the 2024 Call for Proposals

## Collaborative Regional Research Programme (CRRP)

1. Collaborative research on global change and sustainability that, particularly, addresses **GAPS, ANALYSIS, SYNTHESIS and ASSESSMENT** work.
2. Collaborative research that develops **PATHWAYS** and **MECHANISMS** to achieve sustainable development and develop adaptation strategies.
3. Collaborative **PLACE-BASED INTEGRATIVE RESEARCH** particularly from developing countries.
4. Collaborative research that is **CO-DESIGNED** with stakeholders (non-academic) and has actionable outcomes.
5. Collaborative research is in ordance with its mission and activities in APN's 5th Strategic Plan (2020-2026) and contributes to to the implementation of international agendas (Paris Agreement, Sustainable Development Goals, Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction, Global Biodiversity Framework, UN Decade of Ocean Science (2021-2030), and the accumulation of scientific knowledge at IPCC, IPBES, etc)

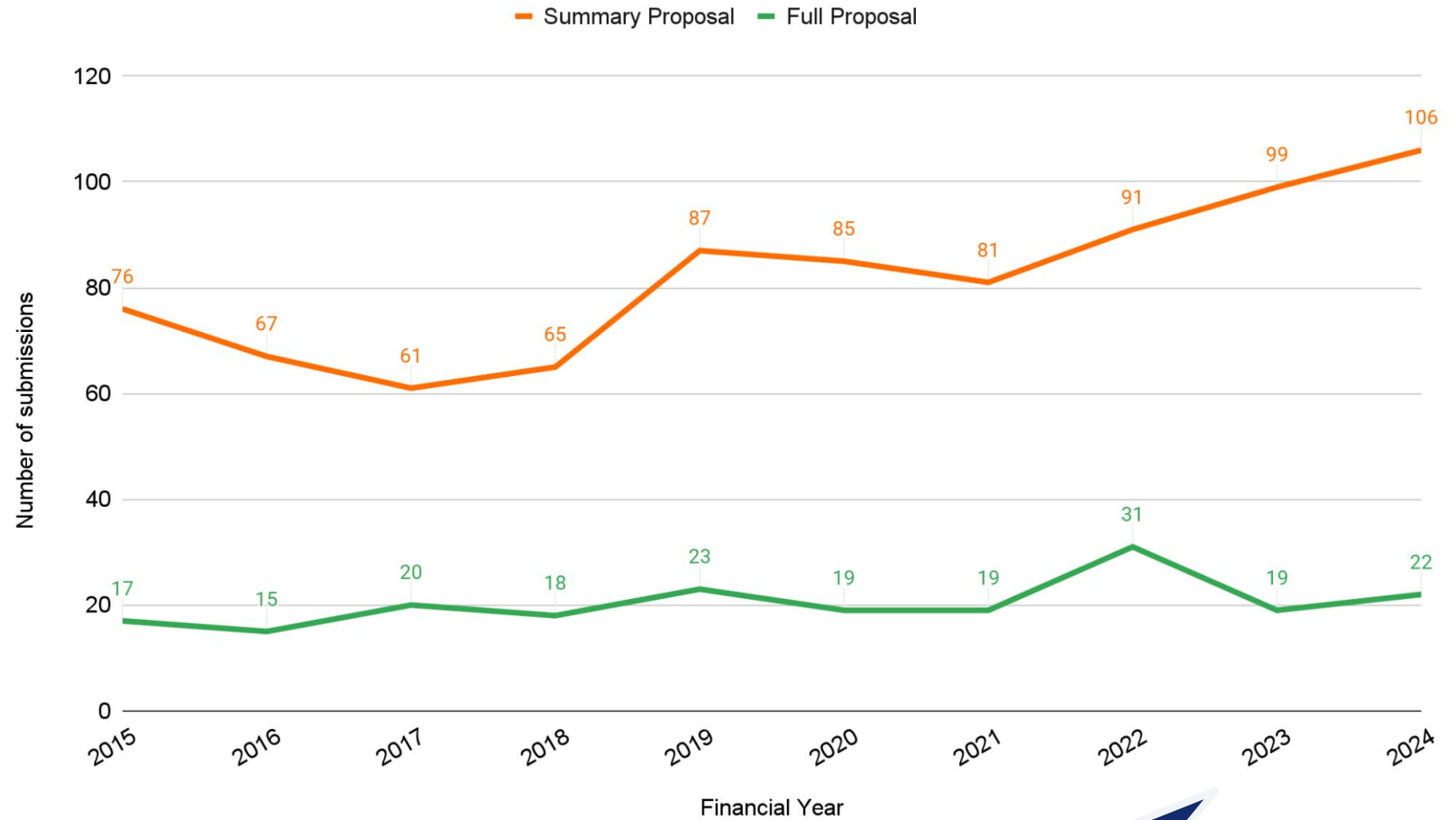
## Scientific Capacity Development Programme (CAPaBLE)

1. Capacity development activities that promote the following approaches related to one or more of the six thematic areas of APN:
  - a. Utilising and strengthening existing capacity
  - b. Creating opportunities to use/instil capacity
  - c. Developing new capacity through innovative approaches;
2. **AWARENESS-RAISING AND DISSEMINATION** activities for policy- and decision-making communities, civil society and/or the general public;
3. **SCIENCE-POLICY** interfacing in the context of the six thematic areas;
4. **CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT PARTNERSHIP ACTIVITIES** that contribute to the capacity development components of the evolving global change arena, including Paris Agreement, Sustainable Development Goals, Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction, Global Biodiversity Framework, UN Decade of Ocean Science (2021-2030), IPCC, IPBES, and new global change and sustainability research programmes.

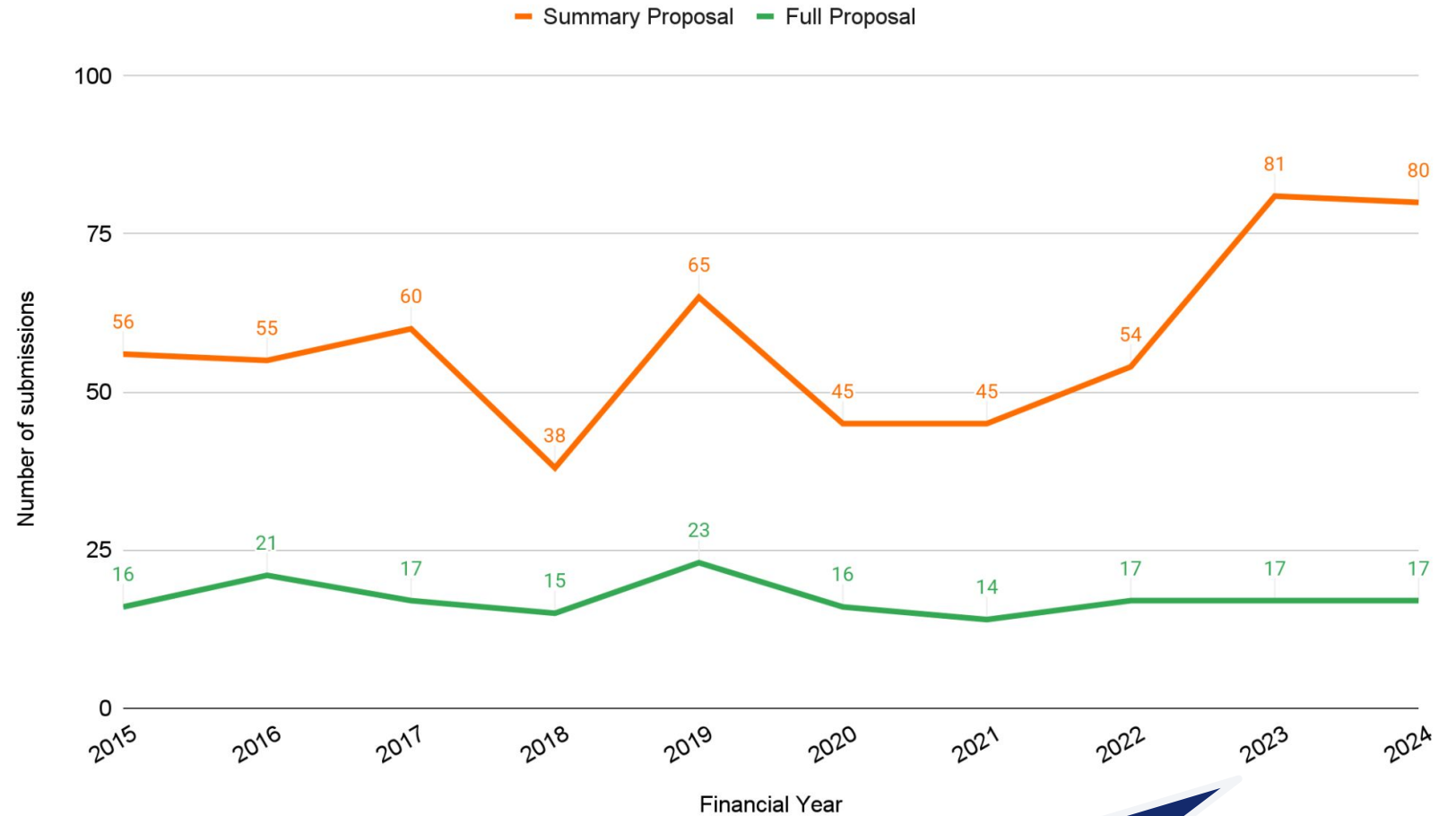

# Rates of success: Scientific Capacity Development (CAPaBLE) Proposals

APN supports research and capacity development activities by inviting proposals under the Collaborative Regional Research Programme (CRRP) and Capacity Development Programme (CAPaBLE).

### Submissions under the Scientific Capacity Development Programme (CAPaBLE)



Average **36.84%** rate of success (FY2023)

## ■ Special consideration for early career professionals



Early career professionals must be under 40 years of age, and should be one of the following:

- A university degree holder with five years of relevant work experience;
- A postgraduate working towards a PhD or a Master's;
- A Master's degree holder with two years of relevant work experience;
- A PhD holder; or,
- A postdoctoral student.

*Special consideration will be given to teams with at least one early career professional from each APN member country or APN approved country engaged in the proposal.*

## ■ Proponent eligibility

- ✓ I am a researcher affiliated with an academic institution/non-profit/government institution based in APN member/approved countries.
- ✓ I am not a consultant nor an independent researcher.
- ✓ I do not work in the private sector.
- ✓ I am not a current Project leader of an APN funded project.
- ✓ I am currently not a collaborator in more than 2 APN funded projects.
- ✓ I have not received more than 135,000 USD of APN funding within the last five years.
- ✓ My CRRP proposal engages 3 countries, 2 of which are developing countries.
- ✓ My CAPaBLE proposal engages 1 or more countries and more than 2 institutions.
- ✓ My proposal addresses one or more of the 2025 priority topics in the selected region.

1. Does the proposed research and activities address global change issues falling under the **sub-regional priority topics**?
2. How far will the proposed activities strengthen the **engagement of scientists/researchers** (*both early career and senior scientists/researchers*) in scientific research and capacity development activities at the regional and international level?
3. In your opinion, could the outcomes of the proposed research be **policy-relevant**?
4. Does the proposal **duplicate** past or current efforts, either funded by APN or supported by any other international/regional organisations? Is the proposal part of any ongoing national/regional/international project/programme?

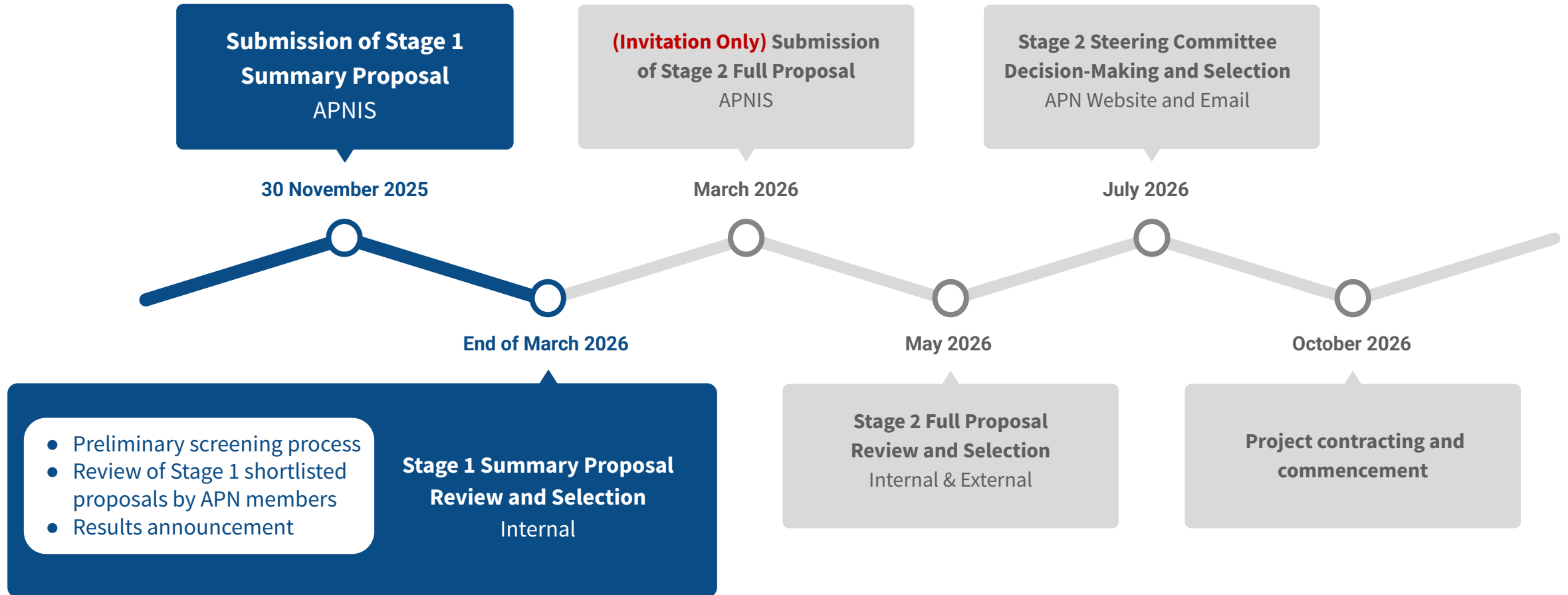

5. Is the proposal **scientifically sound**? In your opinion, with the *methodology* presented in the summary proposal, can the proposed project achieve its expected outputs and outcomes within the *timeframe*?
6. Is the proposal **co-designed and transdisciplinary** in nature?
7. Does the proposal engage **early career professionals** and is the proposal **gender-balanced**?
8. Does the proposal present “**value for money**” and is the requested amount feasible given the budget of the APN?

# ■ Call for Proposals: Summary Proposal Procedure

## Stage 1 Submission

*Deadline: 30 November 2025*

**Proponents:** Prepare and submit proposals to APN through the online interface APN Information System (APNIS).

## Basic eligibility

*December 2025*

**APN Secretariat:** Confirms receipt, reviews proposal for the basic eligibility requirements, and sends to reviewers.

## Stage 1 Review

*January - February 2026*

**APN SPG, CDC, and Invited Experts:** Review and assess the proposals based on the criterion.

## Shortlisting

*February - March 2026*

**APN Secretariat:** Compiles the review scores, and invites successful projects to Stage 2.

## Stage 2 Submission

*Deadline: March 2026*

**Proponents (Invite only):** Preparation and submission of full proposal on APNIS.





### Summary Proposals

Summary proposals must be submitted through the online submission process (<https://www.apn-gcr.org/apnis>). Instructions for completing the online summary proposal are provided below. Note that the deadline for submission is **Sunday, 4 December 2022, midnight (24:00) Japanese Standard Time (JST)**. As the online system will automatically close by the deadline, proponents will be unable to submit a proposal after the deadline.

### Content of Summary Proposals

- Go to the URL: <https://www.apn-gcr.org/apnis>
- Log in to your account if you have already created an account or **create a new user account** if you are a new user. Fill in all the necessary details and click **Register**.
- Once you have logged into your account, you will see the Call for Proposals listed under the box “Call for Proposals”.  
The Call for Proposals will only be visible during the submission period (from launching time to the submission deadline). Note that if you missed the deadline for submission, there will be no opportunity to submit your summary proposal.
